Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
	 Our affiliates include: Financial companies as: WestStar Insurance Agency, Inc., WestStar Bank Holding Company Inc., WestStar Title, LLC. and Sun City Title, LLC.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies:
	 WestStar Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	WestStar Bank doesn't jointly market

Other Important Information

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing – without your authorization.

For California Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing – without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.

For Massachusetts, Mississippi and New Jersey Customers. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing – without your authorization.

For Vermont Members/Customers.

- We will not disclose information about your creditworthiness to our affiliates and will not disclose your personal information, financial information, credit report, or health information to nonaffiliated third parties to market to you, other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.
